Ranging from Mayan temples in Mexico to hidden artifacts in Istanbul, Turkey, from biblical tunnels to the mysteries of Mount Sinai, from the abode of a Sumerian goddess to Greek islands, the Expeditions' destinations and amazing discoveries unmasked established fallacies, detected the fate of provocative artifacts, and revealed ancient connections to modern space facilities.

In this autobiographical book ZECHARIA SITCHIN shares with the reader not only his encompassing knowledge of antiquity and his field experiences, but also hitherto unseen photographs from his personal archive.
